Summary:

Noting that the situation that gave rise to NSAM 41 had improved, Read informed Bundy that intelligence reporting would continue but he wanted permission to stop work responsive to the NSAM. There had been "no indication of any attempts by the French to enlist German or Italian cooperation in the Pierrelatte project."
