Visit Com. G. Traykov and, in the name of the Chairman of the Presidium of the Supreme Soviet of the USSR, Com. N.V. Podgorny, invite Com. G. Traykov for rest and treatment in the Soviet Union at a time convenient to him.

Tell him that during Com. Traykov's time in the USSR he will be rendered the necessary hospitality and attention.
