Summary:

A report written by General Husaynn Kamil Hasan, who is the son-in-law of Saddam Husein, requesting permission to return to Iraq. Kamil says that he has been in contact with Iraqi authorities regarding his return. The document mentions Kamil's recanting of statements he made during a 12 August press conference about overthrowing the Saddam regime.

(Husayn Kamil is thinking of returning to Baghdad)

'Amman—02—19—1996

General Husayn Kamil, son in law of the Iraqi President, has revealed that he is thinking of returning to Baghdad from which, he ran away last August. In addition, he confirmed that he is in touch with the Iraqi Administration in regard to this issue. Today - Monday, in an interview with France Press Agency, General Husayn said: My return to my country is near; it is up to me personally to make this decision after communicating with the Iraqi Administration. The Former Minister of Industry, official of the Military Manufacturing Organization, pointed out that there is no contention between him and the Iraqi President, father of his spouse Raghad, and confirmed that communications between him and Baghdad are still ongoing even though he sought safe haven in Jordan.

In Jordan, on the 12th of last August, during a press conference, Husayn Kamil called for overthrowing the regime of Saddam Hussein, as he held that regime accountable for the suffering of the Iraqi people. However, last Wednesday, in an interview with France Press Agency, he proclaimed that, currently, conditions in Iraq improved in a big way, and spoke well of Baghdad's direction toward political reform and a multi party political system.
