172 - SUNDAY - 1845hs - Continuing here on the official mission of the government this night General Albino Silva, chief of the Casa Militar of the President, that I communicated personally the mission of which he/you is in charge. I will communicate shortly the no of the flight and hour of departure. I am requesting Your Excellency keep me informed by telephone.
