My dear General Van Fleet:

We are very happy to know that you are returning again to the Far East, and I want you to know that the Guest House is all ready for you to occupy.

We were very pleased to receive your cable concerning the hotel manager and will await your arrival before taking further steps. I am enclosing a copy of the proposition the Statler man made to us for your information.

Several rooms are already being rented out at the Bando and it is becoming really urgent to have someone to properly run the hotel, particularly as the advisor we had from United Nations Korean Reconstruction Agency recently was taken ill and his services will not be available for some weeks.

We hope your trip has been a pleasant one and are looking forward to seeing you and Mrs. Van Fleet at the weekend.
