(LETTER OF TRANSMITTAL TO GEN. COULTER)

My dear General:

I am enclosing a copy of the reply by the Commanding General of the Sixth Division, ROK, in response to my message of encouragement.

It is expressive of the determination of the Korean Army to fight back against great odds and of their willingness to die rather than suffer defeat.

It is my sincere hope that the events of the next few days will serve to break the back of the Communist ~~aggression~~ invasion and make possible the victory and the peace for which we all are fighting. But whatever may transpire, please be assured of my whole-hearted support and the best efforts of the ROK Army and the people of Korea in achieving our mutual objectives.
