

Your letter of 4 June 1954, requesting clearance into Korea for Mrs. Salome Han and Mrs. Mina Kim, is acknowledged.

Arrangements have been completed whereby clearance to enter Korea will be granted to Mrs. Han and Mrs. Kim upon their application to the Commanding General, United States Army Forces, Far East, Attention: AG Travel Unit, Pershing Heights, Tokyo. This clearance will provide for their entry into Korea without logistic support from military sources.
