- 0845 - Arrive Kwangsong coast Arty position, Kanghwa island
- 0905 - Depart Arty position
- 0910 - Arrive athletic ground, proceed to Chundung Temple Jeep
- 0920 - Arrive Chundung Temple
- 0945 - Depart Chundung Temple Jeep
- 0955 - Depart athletic ground (Fly over "Mari" mountain if weather permits) H-13
- 1010 - Arrive Kanghwa City, attend people's welcome meeting
- 1115 - Depart Kanghwa island H-13
- 1145 - Arrive Yongsand Pads
