The Michael Leonard Company desires confirmation from the Korean Government on the acceptance and distribution by the Government of approximately 250,000 pounds of sweet corn seed suitable for the varied climatic and agricultural conditions in Korea. The seed would be packaged in quarter pound packages with complete instructions, in Korean, as to planting, growing, harvesting, and preserving methods.

The seed would be provided F.O.B. West Coast without any charge or encumbrance to the Korean Government. The funds for the purchase of the seed would be raised through us, namely, Phillips Associates here in the United States.
