Dear Dr. Rhee:

You will find enclosed a memorandum dictated by Mr. Van L. Phillips of Phillips Associates in Chicago, Illinois. I spent considerable time with Mr. Phillips in connection with his offer to furnish the seed corn for free distribution.

The only obligation that the Korean Government will be under, if the 250,000 pounds of seed corn is accepted, would be to take care of the freight from the West Coast; and, to see that it has proper distribution wherever corn is or can be raised in Korea.
