This letter will be handed to you by James Cromwell who is leaving Friday morning for Korea.

Your letter of September 24th with an invitation to come to Korea after the Christmas Season, has been received and accepted.

Harold Lady had an appointment with Mr. Roberts on October 1st, and that being the day the documents were signed between the United States and Korea, the appointment was made with a Mr. Young of the Department of State. An appointment will be arranged with Mr. Roberts in the next few days.

Harold has every intention of coming to Korea to join you in the herculean task which lies ahead.

I will be looking forward to seeing you and Madame Rhee the first of the year.
