Dear Mr. President:

I am planning to go to Tokyo on 30 April to discuss a number of matters with General Hull, including the visit of General Van Fleet.

Before I leave, it would be most helpful if you could indicate your desires on scheduling and handling General Van Fleet's visit in Korea. If convenient to you, I should like to request an appointment with you on Thursday 29 April to obtain your views on the matter. Thus far, I have very little official information with regard to General Van Fleet's arrival and duration of stay in Korea. I am inclosing a copy of a memorandum from the office of Secretary of Defense which contains my most recent information on this subject.
