Dear Sir:

You are authorized to sell beer to all United Nations Forces in Korea at a rate not to exceed four dollars (\$4.00) a case, one dollar (\$1.00) of which will be credited to purchaser when case and bottles are returned. Cases referred to will be either of the following:

Case of 24 - 22 oz bottles  
Case of 36 - 12 oz bottles

The United Nations Forces use, approximately 75,000 cases a month during the winter season. This rate gradually increases as the weather warms, reaching a peak of over 200,000 cases during July and August.
