REURTEL TWENTYSIX KOREA DESIRES ESTABLISH SOON AS POSSIBLE FREE
ECONOMY WITH CONVERTIBLE CURRENCY USING IMPORT DUTIES AS ONLY DEVICE
FOR IMPLEMENTING MODERATE AUSTERITY PROGRAM AND CHANNELING PRIVATELY
OWNED FOREIGN EXCHANGE INTO PRODUCTIVE ENTERPRISES STOP
PLANNING TO REVISE BUDGET DECREASING DEFICIT STOP WILL DECREASE
CURRENCY IN CIRCULATION BY IMMEDIATELY SELLING LARGE QUANTITIES OF
