I am departing for Chinhae today for a short rest and expect to stay there over the Christmas holidays. Thank you for your two letters of 8 December and news cuttings.

It is distressing to read that one of our foreign service employees is oblivious to the sight of our flag flying up-side down and has no knowledge of its history and the meaning of its figures. I am issuing a strong instruction to the Foreign Ministry to ensure that all personnel be well informed about our flag.

You have no doubt read that Mr. Limb has been appointed to succeed you as Consul General in Sydney, Australia.
