From the President

I have received your letter No. 3 and confidential memorandum concerning the Asia Development Fund. Your analysis of this Plan is very good and I hope that in your conversations with officials of the Philippines Government you will make known these points by way of warning them of the danger of giving support to the Plan.

I note your comments in regard to the appointment of a new Philippines representative and will be pleased to hear further from you in this connection in due course.

I am pleased you invited our people in Manila to dinner to meet them in your home atmosphere. They will have enjoyed themselves and will feel that in future, if they have any problems, they can bring them to you to assist them.
