KOREAN MISSION IN JAPAN

Tokyo, July 11, 1957

TO : His Excellency

In my meetings with the Japs this week, they gave no indication as to whether or no they will accept our amended proposal. At the same time they have no intention of breaking up the talk altogether. We should therefore stick to our original plan and try to succeed.

With the nomination of the new Foreign Minister, I shall have to find out what his attitude and plans are in regard to our problems. And our coming to terms will not be without clashes. What I am worried is the attitude the U.S. will take.
