KOREAN PLAN FOR NEGOTIATION AS OF DECEMBER 27, 1955

1. The Government of Japan will release promptly those Koreans who are under internment in the Immigration Camp in Japan in so far as they have resided in Japan since before the termination of the War.
2. The Government of the Republic of Korea will repatriate promptly those Japanese fishermen who are under internment in the Alien Repatriates Camp in Korea in so far as they have completed their term of imprisonment.
3. The Government of the Republic of Korea will receive repatriates of those Koreans who entered into Japan illegally after the termination of the War and those Koreans who entered into Japan legally but have been already ordered for deportation.

NOTE: This Plan was made to counteract Jap Proposal of same date
by Minister Kim.
