外交部今众社披露关于用我国军赴韩参战或反攻大陆问题。美助理国务卿 Jack K. Mefall 答复共和党议员 Jelly

Brown 致杜总统函要点 (一) 国军主要任务为保卫台湾防中共进犯。(二) 国军与中共军力之对比至少为八比一，且兵源补充不易。中共虽派大军入韩，但沿海及内陆仍有重兵驻守且由内陆增援亦易。凡[X][X]点均应注意。(三) 国军反攻大陆或赴参战之装备必须出自美国，名为用以装备较[多]之韩人为解放其国家而战。(四) 联合国会员反对国民政府军队进攻大陆[X][X]对不少云。顾○○
